

## **HEY KIDS! DO YOU KNOW WHAT TO DO IF THERE IS A FIRE?**

**YELL “FIRE!”** If you see smoke or fire or hear the smoke detector.

**GET LOW AND GO!** Smoke from a fire floats up and is poisonous. So get down low and crawl under the smoke. You can breathe better if you cover your nose with a cloth.

**TOUCH AND KNOW!** If you are in a room with a closed door, check to see if smoke is leaking in around the door and then touch it with the back of your hand. If it feels hot or you see smoke: keep the door closed and stuff sheets or clothes around the bottom of the door. This will help keep smoke out of the room.

-If you live in a one-story house, carefully crawl out the window.

-If you live in a two-story house, use an escape ladder or rope to crawl out the window. If you can't get out, wave a cloth out the window and yell to let people know that you need help.

If the door is cool and there is no smoke: put your shoulder against the door and open it slowly, just a little. Be ready to shut it fast if you feel heat or smell smoke. If there is no smoke or fire, stay low and crawl out of the room and get out of the house.

**GET OUT AND STAY OUT!** Once you get out, immediately go to your safe meeting place. **NEVER GO BACK INTO A BURNING HOUSE FOR ANY REASON.** Make sure Emergency 9-1-1 has been called.
